The annual CIDER program will offer public health practitioners an array of educational opportunities to improve their knowledge and skills in field epidemiology, exercise design, disaster epidemiology and leadership. We will offer a leadership track which focuses on the leadership role, incident command and decision-making.

The CIDER Summer Intensive Program is designed for public health practitioners such as communicable disease investigators, environmental health specialists, epidemiologists, health educators, health officers, laboratorians, medical epidemiologists, public health nurses and public information officers.
