Dr. Huang is the Director of the Communicable Disease Control Unit at the San Francisco Department of Public Health, where she oversees public health surveillance, disease control, and epidemiologic response activities. She was previously the Chief of the Bioterrorism Epidemiology Section, Division of Communicable Disease Control, at the California Department of Health Services. Dr. Huang served as an Epidemic Intelligence Service Officer, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), where she provided technical assistance to health departments in the United States, Canada, Dominican Republic, Guatemala, and Pakistan in the areas of outbreak investigation, surveillance evaluation, and surveys. She is Board-Certified in Internal Medicine and a member of the clinical faculty at the University of California, San Francisco.
